COOKIE POLICY

Our website uses cookies to collect information about its use. This means that when You visit our website, cookies will be placed on Your computer or mobile device. By publishing this Cookie Policy, we demonstrate our commitment to current legal requirements on the use of cookies, providing You with information so you can understand what type of cookies we use and why we do so. In this way, we aim to act transparently as regards the data processed.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on Your computer or mobile device when You visit our website. These files are stored on the user's or visitor's computer or mobile device and contain anonymous data which are not harmful to the system.

HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?

We use cookies to obtain information about Your visits and about the device You use to access our website. This includes where available, Your IP address and pseudonymous identifiers, operating system and browser type and, depending on the cookie, also includes the reporting of statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns.

Cookies allow us to recognise users, tailor the functionality of our website to fit the needs of our website's visitors and helps us improve the user experience.

TYPES OF COOKIES

Cookies are set either by our website (first-party cookies) or by other websites with contents that appear on our website (third-party cookies). In the <u>cookie tables</u> You'll see a description of first-party and third-party cookies that are used. Please note that our <u>cookie tables</u> are not intended to be exhaustive, but rather aim to be representative, and that users and visitors of our website may set additional cookies, depending on the features they have chosen to enable or the plugins they have installed.

We use the following types of first-party cookies on our website:

- a) depending on expiration term:
- Session cookie is a cookie that is automatically deleted when You close your browser after using the website or even earlier. Session cookies help our website remember what You chose on the previous page, avoiding the need to re-enter information and improve Your experience whilst using the website.
- Persistent cookie stay on Your computer or mobile device after You've visited our website. Persistent cookies help us identify You as a unique visitor.
- b) based on the function cookie has and the purpose for which cookie is used:

- Strictly necessary cookies

Are essential in order to enable You to move around the website and use its features. Without these cookies, some services cannot be provided.

- Performance cookies

Gather information about how a website is used – for example, which pages a visitor or user of our website opens most often, and whether the user or visitor receives error messages from some pages. These cookies are used exclusively to improve the performance of the website, and with it the user experience.

- Functional cookies

Enable a website to save information which has already been entered (such as user names), so that it can offer you improved and more personalised functions. Functional cookies are also used to enable features You request.

We use different third party services to enhance the experience of website visitors and to streamline the provision of our services. In our <u>cookie table</u> we have set out links in to service providers we work with who set cookies on our websites, and therefore on Your computer and/or mobile device, each of which have instructions on how to opt out of their cookies. We have no direct control over the information that is collected by these cookies.

Apart from performance cookies, such third-party service providers use:

- Advertising and Targeting cookies, which are used to understand how You use our website and how we can provide a better experience, as well as to deliver content and advertisement that best suits You and Your interests. The information received from these cookies helps us learn things such as what website pages and products You prefer.

HOW TO CONTROL COOKIES?

You can delete all cookies that are already on Your computer or mobile device and You can set most browsers to prevent them from being set. Within your browser You can choose whether You wish to accept cookies or not. Different browsers make different controls available to You. Generally, Your browser will offer You the choice to accept, refuse or delete cookies at all times, or those from providers that website owners use i.e. third party cookies, or those from specific websites. Each browser's website should contain instructions on how You can do this. For example:
